Here are a few steps you can take to make your profile career ready:

#### **Step 1: Clean Up Your Accounts**



- √ Update your profile with a professional photo.
- √ Revise your bio or 'about' section to highlight your best qualities.
- $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$  Remove old posts or photos you would not want an employer to see.
- $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$  Remove any items that do not represent you well.
- √ Check your privacy settings.
- √ 'Unlike' any pages that are no longer relevant to you.
- $\sqrt{\phantom{0}}$  Examine your groups. If they are no longer relevant, leave.
- $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$  Revoke permissions for various games and apps you no longer use.
- $\sqrt{}$  Google search yourself to check all online footprints referencing you.

#### **Step 2: Perform Regular Maintenance**



- $\checkmark$  Consider removing language that may be considered offensive.
- $\checkmark\,\,$  Guard your reputation, be aware of the photos and posts you are tagged in.
- √ On Facebook, change your settings so that you have to approve any photos/ posts you are tagged in.

- Social media moves fast, and you don't want to become the next internet sensation.
- Be prepared to stand behind anything and everything you publish online.
